## What is MOSOMELT?

*MOBILE SOcial Media Learning Technologies (MOSOMELT) is designed as a lecturer professional development strategy based upon distributed communities of practice sharing their experiences utilizing a cMOOC framework.*

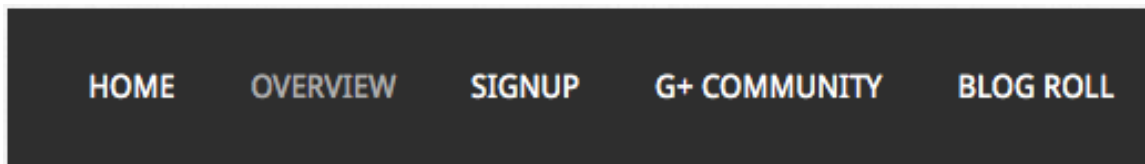
In short, MOSOMELT is a community of lecturers exploring and sharing creative pedagogies and curriculum redesign enabled by mobile social media.

Mosomelt is hosted by the Centre for Learning And Teaching (CfLAT) at Auckland University of Technology.

To be a part of Mosomelt and start contributing to the Mosomelt G+ Community of lecturers, there is an initial "sign up" that needs to be completed. It is also recommended that you use your gmail account to access some of the below. (If you don't have a gmail account, you will need to set one up using the following: [www.gmail.com](http://www.gmail.com), click on Create an account and follow the prompts).

# “SIGNING UP”

You will be required to enter details for different methods of communication that you will be using in Mosomelt.

(If you don't have any of the following requirements, there is a link to each that shows you how to set them up).

NB: A good idea is to have a record of these details somewhere – for future reference!

**Twitter Username** (required)

**Google+ Profile** (required)

1. **Name:** Your first and last name
2. **Email:** Your gmail account
3. **Blog address:** *A journal (or weblog) available on the web.*

The Blog address field requires a “**WordPress**” blog address.

If you don't have a WordPress account, go to:

A series of instructions will be presented to set up your blog: a background theme, your “domain” name (or blog name) and also your login and password.

Your blog address will look something like this: **(yourblogname).wordpress.com**

4. **Twitter Username:** *Is a free social networking microblogging service that allows registered members to broadcast short posts called tweets.*

If you don't have a twitter account, use the following to create one:

Your **twitter Username** will look something like this: **@(yourusername)**

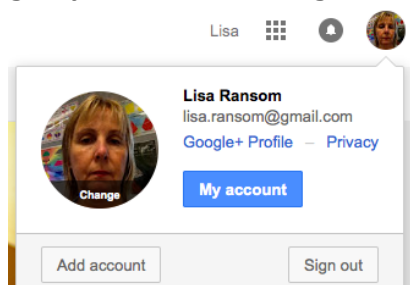
5. **Google + Profile:** *Google + (or Google Plus) is a social network from Google. (can include Maps, Photos, Search, Youtube, Gmail)*

To set up a Google + (Google Plus) account, login in with your gmail account and go to:

<https://plus.google.com> and click on the Sign in Button on the top right hand corner.



Enter your gmail account and password. **Your Google + profile** can be accessed from the drop down area underneath your photo on the top right hand corner. This will also give you access to Google + Communities – a tool that is used widely in this programme.



**NB: WordPress, Twitter and Google + are also available as Apps downloadable to your mobile device.**



This is recommended as the programme encourages full use of mobile.
